Named for the way it mirrors the body's movements, Mirra 2 balances immediate comfort and personalised ergonomics in one sophisticated design that can have a professional or playful aesthetic, depending on the colour palette.

Designed with an "earth first" philosophy, it's an agile, high-performance chair for people who toggle between individual activities and collaborative work.





mirra 2s Harmonic 2 tit, with its responsive leaf-spring design, creates a smooth and balanced feel as you move from one posture to another, whatever your size or stature – from 41 to 159 kilograms.



Moves naturally with you

Support for seated movement starts with a flexible yet supportive design that allows your body to move freely and naturally. Mirra 2's Loop Spine provides torsional flex, allowing you to stretch and reach laterally, while the Harmonic™ 2 tilt provides a smooth, balanced feel as you recline. Passive PostureFit™ sacral support prevents slouching and promotes proper spine alignment.





The Butterfly Back™ is made from a combination of a fabric-and-polymer backrest and a self-contouring seat material that acts like a suspension membrane. The backrest provides three levels of zoned support mapped to your body's anatomy to keep you in healthy alignment as you move. The result is an ultra-responsive chair that conforms to your shape and provides custom support for your body as it eliminates pressure points.



The polymer-only TriFlex™ back has the same self-contouring suspension seat material as the Butterfly Back and the same zones of support created by the size, shape and pattern of the perforations. Because it doesn't have any fabric, the TriFlex back meets more rigorous cleaning protocols.



Every part of the Mirra 2 Chair was painstakingly shaped and reshaped to ensure that each molecule falls into the right place to deliver comfort and support.

Immediate comfort and personalised ergonomics

Mirra 2 moves with you, adapting to your body instantly. Personalised ergonomics come from a variety of features, starting with two back options – Butterfly and TriFlex. Both back options promote airflow so you stay cool, no matter how much you move. The FlexFront seat offers seat depth adjustability to properly support your thighs as you sit, and the AireWeave 2 suspension seat is temperature neutral, so heat doesn't build up as you sit.

Winner of multiple sustainability awards, Mirra 2 was the first office chair developed from the ground up with environmental responsibility in mind. Since it was introduced, we've reduced the environmental footprint further: It's 30 per cent lighter and we've reassessed how every element could be more sustainably made.
