The Rohde Paldao Table features designer Gilbert Rohde's signature curvy freeform shape, which found a place in everything from Herman Miller's first showroom design to mural graphics and finally, these side and coffee tables. Influenced by the abstract art movement and organic shapes, his table was downright revolutionary in the 1940s. As the company's first design director, he helped set Herman Miller on its modernist course—and set the standard for human-centered design: "The most interesting thing in the home is the people who live there and I'm designing for them," he told founder D.J. De Pree during their providential first meeting. Paldao is being reintroduced for the first time in over 80 years.






- Organic form: The table's organic curves mirror the biomorphic art movement of the time


